### Required Documents/Items

- Application** - CC Form 174-R (U.S ARMY GREEN TO GOLD PROGRAM APPLICATION)
  - Signed and dated by individual
  - Signed and dated by Commanding Officer and Field Grade Commander
  - Unit Address i.e. 123 ST EN CO 54TH EN BN, Unit City: FT Base, Unit State: ST 12345
- Enlisted Record Brief**
  - Must Indicate Dependency Status
  - Must Indicate US Citizenship
  - Must verified/signed by MILPO
- Army Physical Fitness Test (APFT) Scorecard** - DA Form 705 (Last 3 required.)
  - Passing score in each event
  - Current Height/Weight (HT/WT) IAW 600-9
  - Dated within the last three (3) months, last 2 must be at least 6 months apart
  - Verified by Commander
- NCO Evaluation Report (DA Form 2166-8) or Awards**-SGT and above must submit last two DA Form 2166-8.  
A SGT that has qualified for only 1 NCOER must submit 1 NCOER.
- Service School Academic Evaluation Report (DA Form 1059)** - latest DA Form 1059 received, if applicable
- Transcripts** - (UNOFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED)
  - Transcripts from all previous colleges attended to include JST
  - High School transcripts (4-YR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS ONLY)
  - SAT/ACT Test Results (4-YR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS ONLY)
- Evaluation of Transfer Credit** (MUST BE FROM THE UNIVERSITY/COLLEGE YOU WILL BE ATTENDING)
  - Must list previous institutions from which Transfer Credits are accepted
  - Must provide academic status and hours accepted towards the degree being pursued
- Planned Academic Program Worksheet** - CC Form 104-R (NOT REQUIRED FOR 4-YR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS).
  - Form must be from the university/college you will be attending
  - Verified, signed, and dated by the student, PMS, and Registrar - (STUDENT MUST SIGN)
  - Must have less than 18hrs per semester/20hrs per quarter
- Applicant Snapshot** - CC Form 103-R
  - Military photo
  - Deployed Soldiers photo taken in Duty Uniform must include a copy of Deployment Orders
- Acceptance Letter from the Professor of Military Science (PMS)**

- Acceptance Letter from the University/College** - (indicating your academic status)
- Letter must be from the university/college you will be enrolling in the **Fall semester**
  - Letter must indicate your status as a first semester **Freshman, Sophomore, Junior, or Graduate**
- Financial Statement** - CC Form 228-R (**SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS ONLY**)
- Form must be verified and signed by Company Commander

- Verification of a favorable or initiated National Agency Check Local Check (NACLC)**
- Medical Examination Forms** - (**NO OTHER FORMS WILL BE ACCEPTED**)
- Exam taken within the last six (6) months
  - DD Form 2351, DoDMERB Report of Medical Examination
  - DD Form 2492, DoDMERB Report of Medical History
- Copy of Waiver(s)** - Civil Conviction, Time-in-Service, Service Obligation, Dependency, etc., if applicable
- Civil Conviction - Court Documents
  - Time-in-Service - DA Form 4187
  - Service Obligation - Specialized Training Service Obligation - DA Form 4187 or Appendix D
  - Dependency Waiver Request
