Methodology

- Allocation based upon four factors:
 - o Type of unit (Ranger/Special Operations, FORSCOM, or other)
 - o Number of Ranger tabs within the unit represents pool of possible competitors
 - o Density of Ranger tabs within the unit represents unit's success/ willingness to send soldiers to Ranger School
 - o 2018 BRC performance (average finish and top finish)
- Focus on allowing more units to compete
- No units get more than four allocations
- All FORSCOM divisions get at least two initial allocations
